**Title:** West Bay continues development of southern Michigan's Rice Creek field

**West Bay** Exploration Co has completed two more Trenton oil producers in southern Michigan's Rice Creek field area approximately six miles northwest of Albion.

The Traverse City, Michigan, independent's 3-1 Hoffman (API 21-025-58853), nw se ne 1-2s-5w, Marengo township, northeastern Calhoun County, initially produced 200 bbls of 42° oil and 85,000 cu ft of gas per day, with no water, on completion in Trenton perforated at 4492-4500 and 4502-06 ft. Total depth is 4700 ft.

It's a mile northeast of West Bay's 1-1 Hoffman, sw sw sw 1-2s-5w, which was completed initially producing 160 bbls of 42° oil and 80,000 cu ft of gas daily from Trenton at 4450-60 ft.

A mile to the south-southwest, West Bay produced oil at an initial rate of 130 bbls per day, with 95,000 cu ft of gas daily, on completion of the 4-12 Double Eagle Farms (API 21-025-58627) in se ne nw 12-2s-5w. Production at this well is from an acidized Trenton interval at 4400-16 ft. Total depth is 4498 ft. The top of Trenton was logged at 4138 ft from a kelly bushing elevation of 960 ft. It offsets to the southeast the company's 2-12 Double Eagle Farms, nw ne nw 12-2s-5w, which was completed last year producing 160 bbls of oil and 80,000 cu ft of gas daily from Trenton at 4456-76 ft.

West Bay recently completed another 200-bbl-a-day Trenton oil producer in the new field at the 1-2 Hoffman in ne se se 2-2s-5w. The latter well was completed through perforations at 4443-58 ft.
