West Bay flows oil on two more Calhoun County tests, runs pipe on another

CALHOUN COUNTY, Mich. — West Bay Exploration has scored two more apparent successes in its Ordovician Trenton play here, reportedly flowing oil at rates of approximately 160 barrels per day each on tests of two wells drilled in March and April 2007 in northeastern Marengo Township, T2S-R5W.

Production casing was set last week on West Bay's latest try, in Section 29 of neighboring Sheridan Township (T2S-R4W), to the southeast.

Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Geological Survey field reports indicate that West Bay has successfully completed the Double Eagle Farms 2-12 (SL: NW NE NW, Sec 12-T2S-R5W), directionally drilled from March 13

to March 26 to a measured total depth of 4,800 feet, and the Hoffman 1-1 (SL: SW SW SW, Sec 1-T2S-R5W, Marengo Twp., Calhoun Co.), drilled from April 6 to April 18 to a total depth of 4,500 feet.

The wells are located to the northwest of West Bay's mid-2006 Foote 1-12 well (SL: NE SW NE, Sec 12-T2S-R5W), which kicked off a significant land and exploration play when it was completed for 192 barrels oil daily in a previously unproductive area near Albion-Scipio Trend production to the southeast and northwest.

Completion details on the Hoffman 1-1 indicate that West Bay perforated the hole from 4,450 feet to 4,460 feet and treated the interval with 500 gallons acid. That well

was reported flowing at a rate of 160 barrels oil daily in early May testing. West Bay has constructed a production facility on the site of the Double Eagle Farms 2-12, according to Office of Geological Survey field geologist Kristine Shimko.

Advanced Energy Services Rig 2, which drilled both the Double Eagle Farms 2-12 and Hoffman 1-1 wells, completed drilling on May 4 on West Bay's Starr Commonwealth 1-29 (SL: C SW SE, Sec 29-T2S-

R4W, Sheridan Twp., Calhoun Co.). That well is located approximately 3.5 miles southeast of the wells in Sections 1 and 12 of Marengo Township. Five and one-half inch production casing was set to a depth of 4,319 feet, with a McConnell & Scully workover rig moved in to drill out cement and perforate, according to Office of Geological Survey geologist Dave Bechler.

Advanced Energy Rig 2 has commenced *(continued on page 22)*

drilling on West Bay's Mullet 1-23 (SL: NE SE SE, Sec 23-T1S-R5W, Lee Twp., Calhoun Co.), located to the north of the Marengo Township wells.
